



## BUTTON MUSHROOM PATTERN

Abbreviations:

MR	Magic ring
Sl st	Slip stitch
Sc	Single crochet
sc2tog	Single crochet two stitches together
Rnd	Round
St	Stitch

The size of your mushroom will depend on the size of the yarn and hook you use. The bigger the yarn, the fuller the fungi!

Create a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 4 sc into MR, place marker to mark beginning on rounds

Rnd 2: 2 sc into each st around

Rnd 3: \*2 sc, 1 sc\* repeat from \* to marker

Rnd 4: same as rnd 3

Rnd 5: 1 sc in each st around

Rnd 6: 1 sc, sc2tog\* repeat from \* to marker

Rnd 7: same as rnd 6

Rnd 8: sc2tog in each st around (6 sts should remain)

Rnd 9-14: 1 sc in each st around, Sl st in last stitch of rnd 14, weave in ends

Shape mushroom by rounding out the cap and pushing the stem up into it. If necessary a few stitches can be added to hold it into place.

Optional: For a two tone mushroom, crochet rounds 1-8 in the colour of your choice (darker brown or red are favs of mine) and change colours at round 9 to make a contrasting stem.



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
